

Uberspace mail

If there's no MX pointing to the Uberspace server, every mailbox will end up on @\$USER.uber.space

addresses like `☐.$USER.uber.space` (i.e. created as punycode variant `xn--du8h` are inconsistent between server and client. ([src](#))

Here I just have to experiment more.

Because of the parallels to domains I assume that punycode can also be applied to mail addresses and that emojis can be used as normal ASCII chars.

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
